





Hawaii, Kilauea Lava Flow (2014-2015)




Nepal M7.8 Earthquake (2015)

### Dashboard

The **DisasterAWARE™** Dashboard is an enhanced feature that supports situational awareness and information sharing during high-interest, response events that may require Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief.

DisasterAWARE™ Dashboard delivers an immediate visual display for monitoring significant event information, simplifying the decision-making process. This specialized functionality translates into quick status updates, through features such as Timeline and Event Log.
